SUMMARY (Inserted for descriptive purposes. The summary is not part of the amended rule.)

Rule 61J2-2.032, Informal Hearings, was amended effective February 4, 2004. The rule was amended to bring it into compliance with statutory changes. The change replaces the term "salesperson" with the new term "sales associate".

CODED TEXT

61J2-2.032: Informal Hearings, effective February 4, 2004

When an applicant for licensure as a real estate sales associate ~~salesperson~~ or broker requests a s. 120.57(2), F.S., informal hearing before the Commission, in addition to other requirements of law, before the applicant shall be considered for approval to sit for the real estate examination, the applicant must submit at least 3 letters of reference from persons who know of the applicant's honesty, truthfulness, trustworthiness, good character and good reputation for fair dealing as required in s. 475.17(1)(a), F.S. At least 2 of the letters must be from individuals not related to the applicant.
